Exclusive tours "The story of the Ladies of Chenonceau" from July 31 to October 24.

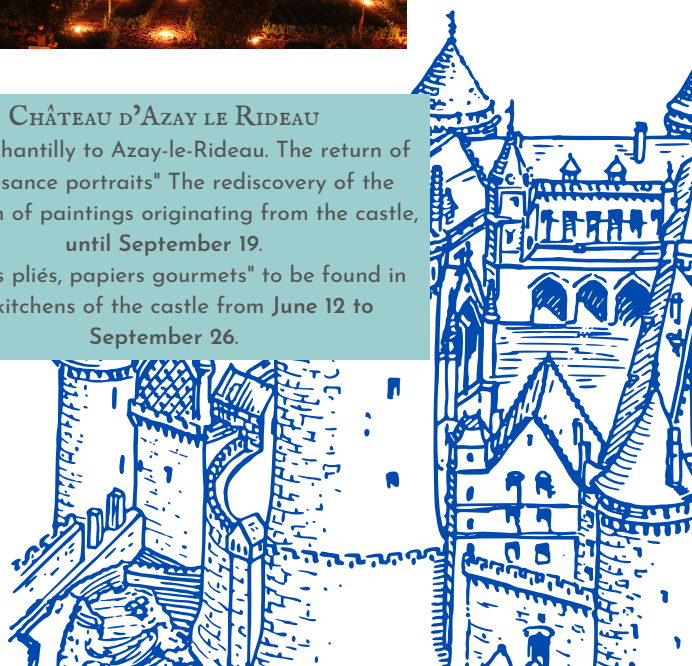
CHÂTEAU ET JARDINS DE VILLANDRY

CHÂTEAU DU RIVAU

Artists from all fields expose their perceptions of food in art with the exhibition "The Taste of Art, the Art of Taste".

CITÉ ROYALE DE LOCHES

Discover the royal and fantastic animals with the exhibition "Animalis" until September 19th.

Chancellery of Loches: Exhibition of one of the richest treasures in the world "The treasure of San Gennaro of Naples" until October 1st.



FORTERESSE ROYALE DE CHINON

A space dedicated to the house of Plantagenêt with the reconstitution of the bedroom of Eleanor of Aquitaine and Henry II Plantagenêt.

The exhibition "Myths and Legends of the Fortress" presents the emblematic personalities of the Royal Fortress of Chinon, still shrouded in mystery today... to be discovered until November 7.



CHÂTEAU ET PARC DE LANGEAIS

An invitation to experience the marriage of Charles VII and Anne of Brittany during an immersive scenography narrated by the famous Stéphane Bern.

The Château de Langeais has a rich collection of tapestries from the 15th and 16th centuries that can now be admired in the new room dedicated to this art.



CHÂTEAU DE CHAMBORD

The exhibition "Arborescences" by Lydie Arickx, a hymn to life to be discovered until October 17. For the 10th anniversary of its festival, Chambord offers 17 concerts and many surprises, from July 3 to 17.

But also: the equestrian show, guided tours of the vegetable gardens and 4x4 tours of the forest park.

CHÂTEAU DE CHEVERNY

A 6th garden, the " Sweet Garden " is being created in the park of the Château de Cheverny. "The Secrets of Moulinsart", an interactive exhibition unique in France, created with the Hergé Foundation, takes you to the heart of Tintin's adventures!

DOMAINE RÉGIONAL DE CHAUMONT-SUR-LOIRE

This new edition of the International Festival of the Garden will honor "Biomimicry in the Garden - Nature as Infinite Source of Inspiration" through the works of international contemporary artists, until November 1st.



CHÂTEAU ROYAL DE BLOIS

Qi Gong at the Royal Castle of Blois until June 26, in the royal gardens.
Giant Escape Game " The crazy escape of Marie de Medici " until November 6.
The exhibition "Un château sans / 100 clichés" offers an offbeat view of the monument and its history, until November 22.
The Sound & Light show at the Royal Castle to be seen every evening from July 1 to September 26 and from October 23 to November 6.



CHÂTEAU DE SULLY-SUR-LOIRE

The photographer Robert Doisneau recounts the history of the Loire through black and white pictures, until November 1st.
Exhibition " Stories of Women " at the castle on 5 women who have marked the history of the castle, from July 14 to October 17.



CHÂTEAU DE VALENÇAY

The exhibition "From the Louvre to Valençay, 1939-1946" takes us on a journey of discovery through the history of the castle during the Second World War when the major works of the Louvre were housed there, until November 11.
In the fall, the castle welcomes internationally renowned artists for the Talleyrand Festival on ancient instruments.
